

What can I do for the PTO?

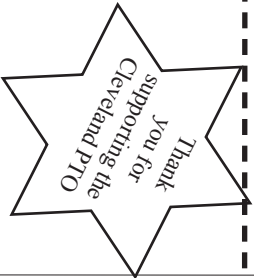

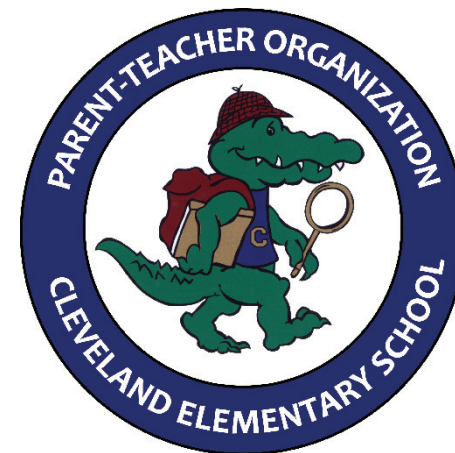
